#### **POVERTY SIMULATION**

On Friday, September 22nd, CPCA staff (Carol Currie, Cynthia Fair, Sandra Rush, and Andrea Wiley) participated in the Community Action Network Poverty Simulation hosted by Chatham County Department of Social Services at the Chatham County Agricultural Center in Pittsboro. The immersive experience is designed to help participants understand the harsh realities of life in poverty. During the simulation, participants were confronted with a series of real-world challenges that mimic the complex, daily obstacles that many individuals and families in our community must confront to survive. The simulation helps build empathy for families living in poverty, and it is an effective tool for rethinking issues of poverty and effective responses by the community. Sandra spoke for all when she reflected that "Eyes were opened through the event that those in poverty have real struggles."
